





MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN PAKISTAN BAIT-UL-MAL AND GOVERNMENT COLLEGE WOMEN UNIVERSITY

This MOU is made between Pakistan BAIT-UL-MAL Poverty Alleviation and Social Safety Divisions, Government of Pakistan (hereinafter referred to as PBM and Government College Women University Sialkot (hereinafter referred to as GCWUS) at Sialkot on this day the 30 JAN, 2020 and will be effective with IMMEDIATE EFFECT and last for ONE YEAR, which can be renewed with mutual written consent of both parties

SIALKOT

WHEREAS, PBM being social protection organization of the Federal Government undertake projects/programs /activities for the welfare of poorest of the poor throughout Pakistan, with its presence in each district. Its objectives include (1) assumption of minimum well-being through a guarantee of provision of essential goods and services for protection against life contingencies for all people, (2) Adoption of proactive strategies and policies to prevent against life risks, and (3) promotion of individual and social potentials and opportunities .The foundation of these objective is to encourage poverty reduction and sustainable development.

AND WHEREAS GCWUS is a Center of Excellence among Higher Education Institutions of Pakistan, leading the country towards a rapidly developing Knowledge Economy and Progressive State among comity of nation, focusing on creativity, innovation and entrepreneurship so as to amicably negotiate Social, Economic and Environmental challenges faced by the country.

And WHEREAS, PBM through its IFA Education policy, provide IFA stipends amounting PKR 05 (FIVE) Million to poor deserving brilliant students of GCWUS covering FY 2019/2020. The students will be recommended by FAC of GCWUS and the list shall be forwarded to PBM for further processing as per IFA Education Policy and standard SOPs.

AND WHEREAS, PBM will provide internship / participation to community work, to the students of GCWUS as per their degree requirements and as per the recommendations of the FAC Committee in any of its District Offices across the country, Regional Offices at Lahore, Multan, Gilgit-Baltistan and Islamabad, Provincial Offices at Karachi, Peshawar and Quetta and Head Office at Islamabad.

AND WHEREAS, PBM and GCWUS will jointly hold National and International days like Universal Children's Day, International Women's Day, International Thalassemia Day, World Blood Donor Day, International Day for Economic and Social Developments, World AIDS Day etc. Logistic support and other arrangements will be the responsibility of GCWUS and financial expenditure if any will be borne by PBM.

AND WHEREAS GCWUS, through their research scholars will carry out impact Evaluation Studies, Environmental and social System Assessment, Impact Assessment of different programs, assessment of poverty Measurements and consequently their impact of innovation on PBM upon request of PBM. Evaluative research is undertaken to assess the worth/success of something (a program, a policy or a project)

This impact evaluation will be on gratis basis and if any fee is involved that will mutually be agreed upon by both parties before the research is carried out.

AND WHEREAS both PBM and GCWUS reserve the right to amend this MOU at any time through mutual written consent. The party wishing so must give the other party a written notice of one month

AND WHEREAS this MOU may Be terminated by either party by giving notice of two months to other party of its intention to terminate this MOU

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the undersigned representatives, duly authorized by PAKISTAN BAIT-MAL and GOVERMETN College Women University Sialkot. respectively have signed this Memorandum of Understanding.
